Don't pour chemicals down your sinks or storm drains where they enter local creeks and lakes untreated. Never place household chemicals in your trash or recycling containers.

Environmental Waste Services collects your chemicals for free. Acceptable products are recycled, processed and available for reuse at Plano's Household Chemical Reuse Center. If unacceptable for reuse, then chemicals are disposed of properly.

DO YOU HAVE UNWANTED PAINT OR CHEMICALS IN YOUR HOME?



Read the labels. Leftover chemicals are household hazardous waste (HHW) and are labeled accordingly - "caution," "warning," "danger" or "poison."

Chemicals include several types of waste, such as:

- Toxins: pesticides and herbicides
- Reactives: pool chlorine and bleach products
- Flammables: gasoline, aerosols, oil-based paint and turpentine
- Corrosives: ammonia and acid batteries

WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF STORING LEFTOVER CHEMICALS INDEFINITELY?



- Children and pets are at risk for poisoning from improperly stored chemicals.
- Unsealed lids can release toxic or flammable vapors.
- Brittle containers may leak.
- Expired chemicals may not be effective.
