Subject: Fees for Fire Inspections

Dear Plano Business Owner:

As a part of the City's annual 2010 budget review and Core Matrix Business Model program study, the Fire Department was tasked with identifying the cost for providing fire inspection services. Fire inspections are required to be conducted by the Fire Department in accordance with the International Fire Code. In the last Legislative session, a law was passed requiring anyone conducting fire inspections to be certified by the State through the Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP).

Fire inspections are conducted to help insure the fire safety of your property, patrons, and employees, as well as the fire fighters who respond to calls for emergency assistance. It is our goal to provide an educational based fire safety inspection in accordance with the adopted codes and ordinances of the City of Plano.

We hope through this joint effort you will find the inspection to be informative and educational to help you maintain a safe environment.
