MUO



The Medical Unit Overload (MUO) plan had 2 activations in July 2016 compared to 3 activations in July 2015. The plan was activated a total of 4 times in the last quarter compared to 11 times in the same quarter one year ago.

CARES



Cardiac survival rates for the month of July 2016 were at an overall rate of 30.8% (4 cases out of 13). In July 2015 the survival rate was at 22.2% (2 cases out of 9).

Community Outreach



A total of 25 Public Education programs were offered to an audience of 942 in July 2016 compared to 38 programs and an audience of 1,057 in July 2015. Two CPR classes with 39 total students were taught in July 2016 compared to 1 CPR class with 40 total students in July 2015.

Transported patients were received at 17 area hospitals in July 2016.

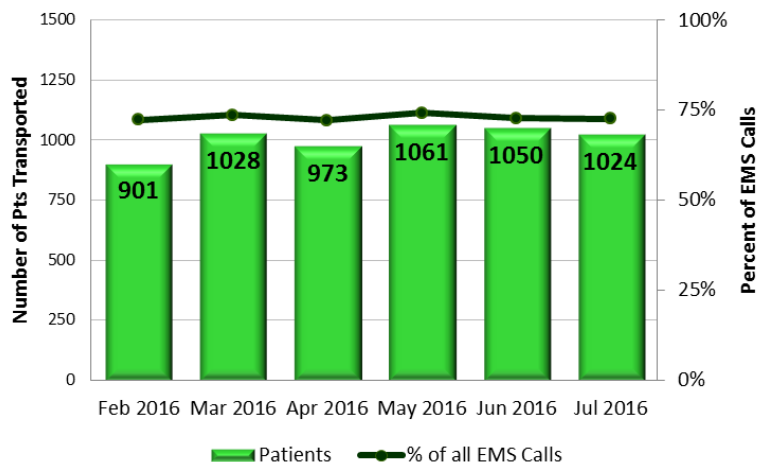

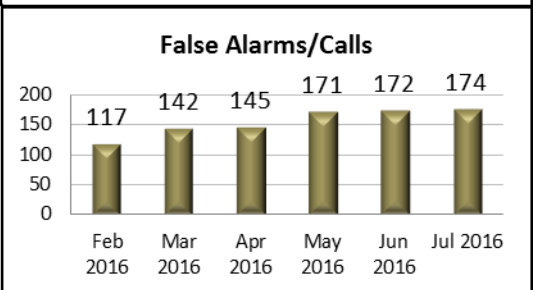
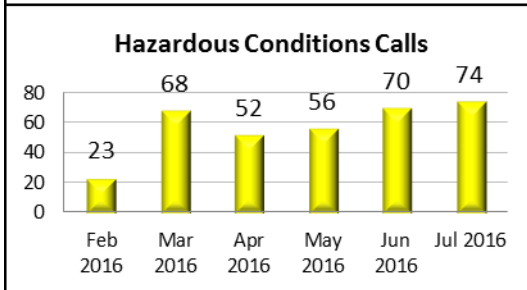
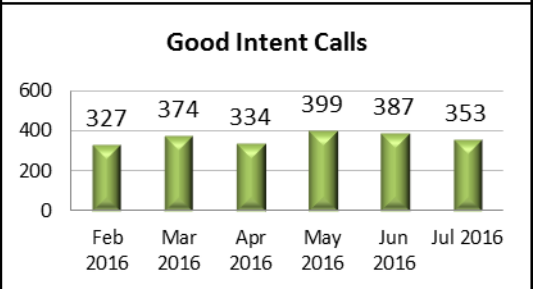
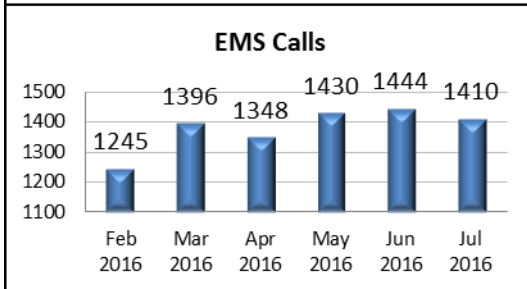
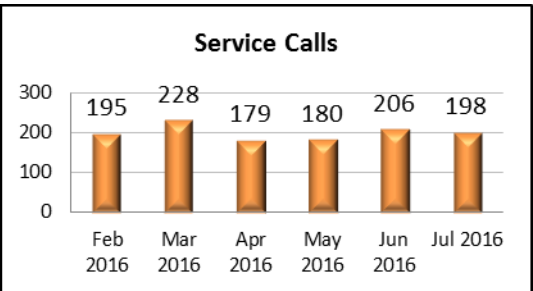
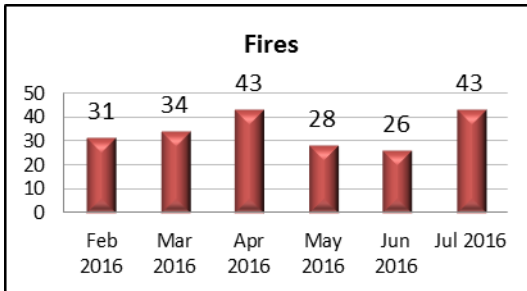




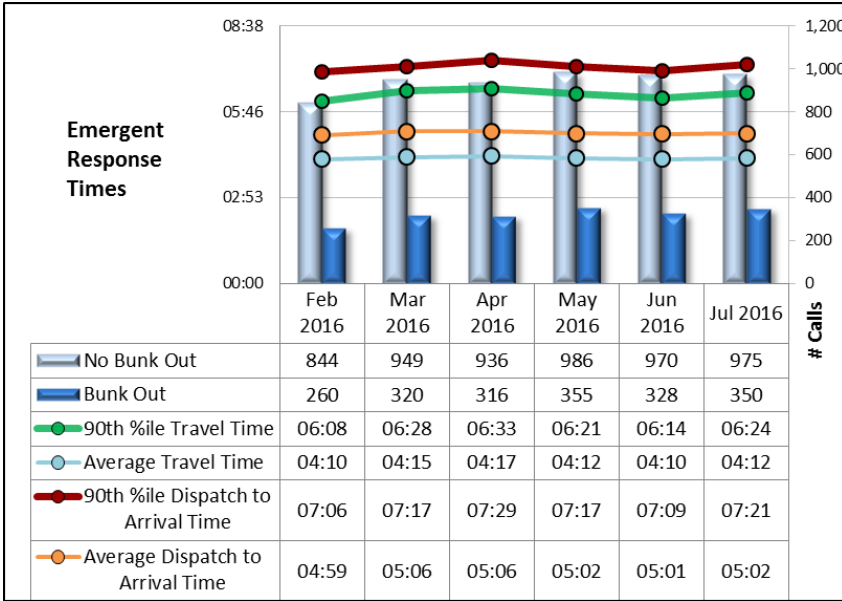
CALLS FOR SERVICE

CALLS BY NFIRS TYPE

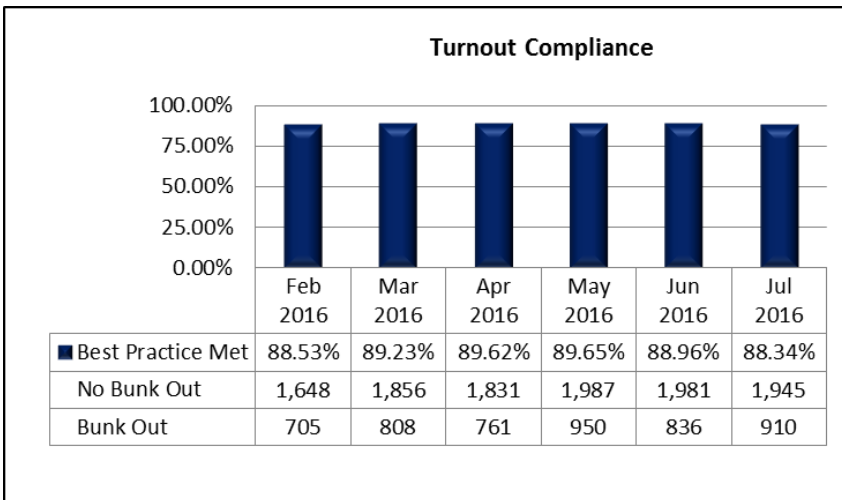
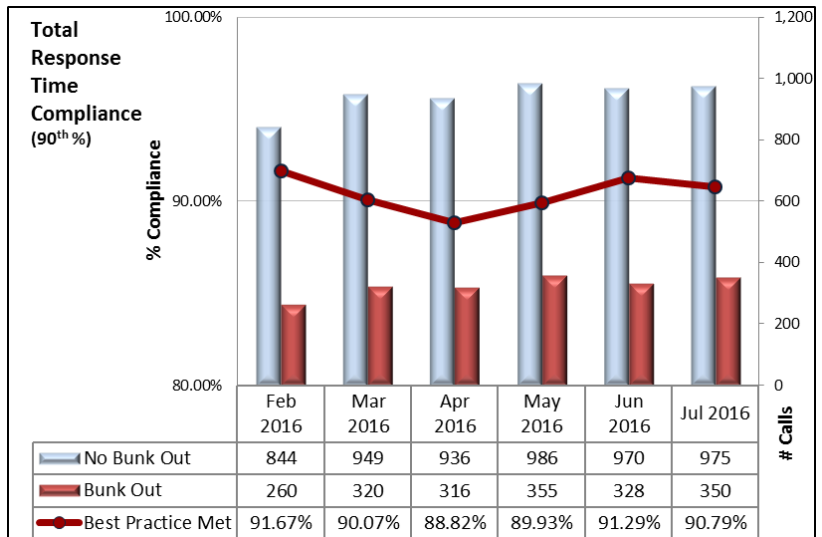


Response Time

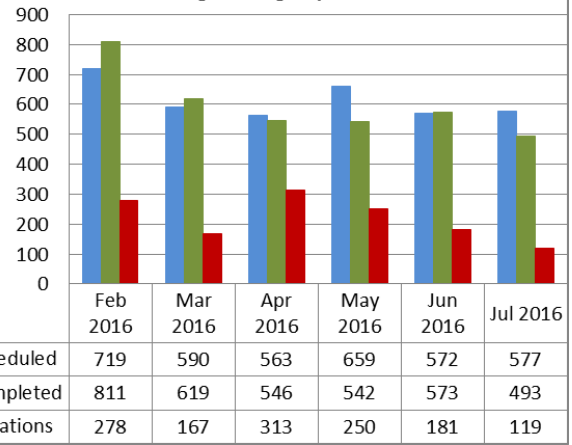

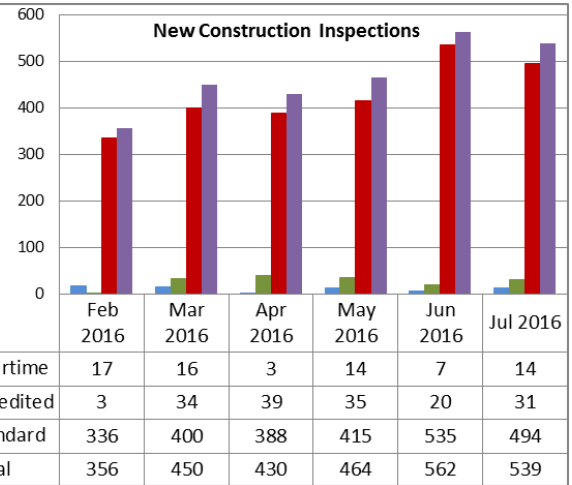
