SNAP STEAM Saturdays (all ages)

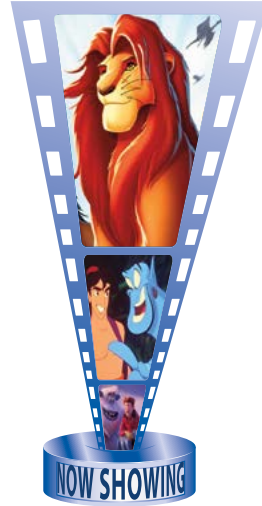
