Welcome to the Plano Aerobats Gymnastics program! Outlined here are our rules and policies. Please refer to the calendar enclosed, as we do not always follow the PISD's calendar when holidays are concerned.

Thank you for showing an interest in our program, and allowing us the opportunity to develop your child's gymnastic ability. A liability waiver must be completed and turned in prior to taking the first class. Liability waivers can be obtained from the gymnastics office or our web site at planoerobats.org.

*A leotard is a **must** for all girls. Boys need to wear gym shorts and tee shirts. Tights with feet in them and socks are discouraged. Long hair must be pulled back in a ponytail.

***There are no make-ups for classes missed.**

*We welcome parents to view any class from the parent viewing area, but not from within the gymnastics room.

*The student teacher ratio in all classes is 8:1.

*The students are placed into classes according to their age and ability. Girls will receive instruction on each of the four main pieces of equipment; bars, beam, floor and vault. They are taught skills that are a part of the USA Gymnastics progressive skills program, and are continuously evaluated and moved up to the next level upon the head coach's recommendation. Boys are taught beginner level skills only on the six main pieces of equipment: Pommel Horse, Rings, High Bar, Floor, Vault and Parallel Bars.

*Classes are held at both Carpenter Park and Oak Point Recreation Centers.

CLASSES OFFERED

Kindergym - Girls ages 3-5 Beginning Level

Classes are held in the mornings/evenings, Monday through Saturday.



Boys Program - Boys ages 4-8 Beginning-Intermediate Level

Classes are held at 3:30pm, Monday through Friday.



Blue & White Team - Girls ages 6-12 Beginning/Intermediate Levels

Classes are held Monday through Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings.



Red Team – Girls ages 6-14 Advanced beginner Levels 2-4

Classes are held Mondays and Wednesdays, 5:30pm-7pm.



Gold Team

Advanced girls, Levels 3 through 8, ages 6-16, who compete in TAAF and USAG gymnastics meets throughout the Metroplex.

9 hours/week \$145
11 hours/week \$166
13 hours/week \$187

*Non residents pay an additional \$4/month/child

*Each additional child from the same family receives a \$2 per month discount.

***Payments are due during the first week of each month. After the 10th of each month, you will be charged a \$10 late fee unless previous arrangements have been made with Vickie.**

*Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. You may also sign up for our auto-pay program where we automatically charge your credit/debit card each month.

*Checks are made payable to "City of Plano".

*If you choose to discontinue the program, you must notify us **in writing** before the first of the month. Otherwise, you will be responsible for that month's tuition.

*If you begin classes with the Aerobats at a time other than the first of the month, your first month's tuition will be prorated.

*The full tuition is due each month regardless of the number of classes missed or the number of days the gym is closed due to holidays.
