



## City of Plano – Homelessness Prevention Program

The goal of this program is to help prevent homelessness with limited financial assistance. Due to the COVID-19 emergency, the scope of the program has been temporarily expanded. The three categories of assistance available at this time and basic eligibility criteria are described below. ### **Interim COVID-19 Hotel Assistance – At Risk of Homelessness**

Temporary assistance for people living in a hotel in Plano who lack the resources and support to avoid becoming homeless.

### **Interim COVID-19 Hotel Assistance – Persons Experiencing Homelessness**

Temporary assistance for people experiencing unsheltered homelessness in Plano who 1) are referred by Plano Police Department, 2) test positive for COVID-19, or 3) have a documented recommendation from a medical professional to quarantine/isolate.

### **Rent and Mortgage Assistance – At Risk of Homelessness**

Temporary assistance for Plano residents with a lease agreement or mortgage who have received a late notice or notice to vacate.

### **Basic Eligibility Criteria – All Applicants:**

- Applicant must be a Plano resident.
- Applicant should verify the crisis situation leading to the risk of homelessness and lacks adequate support networks and financial resources to avoid becoming homeless.

- Willing to work with case manager to complete a housing stability plan and take meaningful steps to achieve stability goals.
- Applicant's household must be at or below 80% of the Dallas, TX HUD Metro Area Median Income (AMI) Limits.
